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1. Permittee shall notify KSC security a minimum of 24 hours in advance of beginning event. No need to call when departing event. KSC security 321-867-2121

 In addition to complying with the Operating Rules and Laws referenced in the General Conditions, the permittee should familiarize themselves with Refuge Specific Regulations found in Title 50, Code of Federal Regulations governing National Wildlife Refuges and the area described in this permit.

3. Permittee shall remove all materials, equipment, supplies, etc. from the refuge immediately upon completion of the event

4. Camping, sunbathing, fishing, or any other use not described in the permit application is not permitted.

5. Permittees may be responsible for providing written reports to the issuing officer who summarizes use activities and accomplishments in accomplishing authorized uses. Summary of number of participants in events must be submitted annually no later than August 31st.

6. Failure by the Permittee or authorized assistant(s) to comply with any of the provisions or violation of any refuge regulation or any State law or regulation applicable to the described use, not only shall render permittee subject to prosecution under said laws and regulations, but shall constitute a case for revocation of this permit.

7. This permit may be terminated at any time by the issuing officer or other refuge personnel.

8. The Refuge Manager reserves the right to restrict access to the refuge due to weather, wet conditions, wildlife activity, etc. Permittee is responsible for repairing any damage caused to the refuge.

9. Permittee and all sub-permittees must keep a copy of this permit with them at all times while on the refuge.
